(Jeremiah 16:15) "But, The LORD liveth, that brought up the children of Israel from the land of the north, and from all the lands whither he had driven them: and I will bring them again into their land that I gave unto their fathers."

Jeremiah 29:10 ¶ For thus saith the LORD, That after seventy years be accomplished at Babylon I will visit you, and perform my good word toward you, in causing you to return to this place.

(Psalms 90:10) "The days of our years are threescore years and ten; and if by reason of strength they be fourscore years, yet is their strength labour and sorrow; for it is soon cut off, and we fly away."

(Matthew 24:34) "Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled."

(Mark 13:30) "Verily I say unto you, that this generation shall not pass, till all these things be done."

(Luke 21:32) "Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass away, till all be fulfilled."

GENERATION

(Genesis 2:4) "¶ These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens,"

(Genesis 5:1) "This is the book of the generations of Adam. In the day that God created man, in the likeness of God made he him;"

Genesis 6:9 These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God.

(Genesis 7:1) "And the LORD said unto Noah, Come thou and all thy house into the ark; for thee have I seen righteous before me in this generation."

(Genesis 9:12) "And God said, This is the token of the covenant which I make between me and you and every living creature that is with you, for perpetual generations:"

(Genesis 10:1) "Now these are the generations of the sons of Noah, Shem, Ham, and Japheth: and unto them were sons born after the flood."

(Genesis 10:32) "These are the families of the sons of Noah, after their generations, in their nations: and by these were the nations divided in the earth after the flood."

(Genesis 11:10) "¶ These are the generations of Shem: Shem was an hundred years old, and begat Arphaxad two years after the flood:"

(Genesis 15:16) "But in the fourth generation they shall come hither again: for the iniquity of the Amorites is not yet full."

(Genesis 17:7) "And I will establish my covenant between me and thee and thy seed after thee in their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be a God unto thee, and to thy seed after thee."

(Genesis 17:9) "¶ And God said unto Abraham, Thou shalt keep my covenant therefore, thou, and thy seed after thee in their generations."

(Genesis 17:12) "And he that is eight days old shall be circumcised among you, every man child in your generations, he that is born in the house, or bought with money of any stranger, which is not of thy seed."

(Genesis 25:12-13) "¶ Now these are the generations of Ishmael, Abraham's son, whom Hagar the Egyptian, Sarah's handmaid, bare unto Abraham: {13} And these are the names of the sons of Ishmael, by their names, according to their generations: the firstborn of Ishmael, Nebajoth; and Kedar, and Adbeel, and Mibsam,"

(Genesis 36:1) "Now these are the generations of Esau, who is Edom."

(Genesis 37:2) "These are the generations of Jacob. Joseph, being seventeen years old, was feeding the flock with his brethren; and the lad was with the sons of Bilhah, and with the sons of Zilpah, his father's wives: and Joseph brought unto his father their evil report."

(Exodus 3:15) "And God said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this is my name for ever, and this is my memorial unto all generations."

(Exodus 6:16) "¶ And these are the names of the sons of Levi according to their generations; Gershon, and Kohath, and Merari: and the years of the life of Levi were an hundred thirty and seven years."

(Exodus 6:19) "And the sons of Merari; Mahali and Mushi: these are the families of Levi according to their generations."

(Exodus 12:14) "And this day shall be unto you for a memorial; and ye shall keep it a feast to the LORD throughout your generations; ye shall keep it a feast by an ordinance for ever."

(Exodus 12:17) "And ye shall observe the feast of unleavened bread; for in this selfsame day have I brought your armies out of the land of Egypt: therefore shall ye observe this day in your generations by an ordinance for ever."

(Exodus 12:42) "It is a night to be much observed unto the LORD for bringing them out from the land of Egypt: this is that night of the LORD to be observed of all the children of Israel in their generations."

(Exodus 16:32) "¶ And Moses said, This is the thing which the LORD commandeth, Fill an omer of it to be kept for your generations; that they may see the bread wherewith I have fed you in the wilderness, when I brought you forth from the land of Egypt."

(Exodus 17:16) "For he said, Because the LORD hath sworn that the LORD will have war with Amalek from generation to generation."

(Exodus 20:5) "Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;"

(Exodus 27:21) "In the tabernacle of the congregation without the vail, which is before the testimony, Aaron and his sons shall order it from evening to morning before the LORD: it shall be a statute for ever unto their generations on the behalf of the children of Israel."

(Exodus 29:42) "This shall be a continual burnt offering throughout your generations at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the LORD: where I will meet you, to speak there unto thee."

(Exodus 30:8) "And when Aaron lighteth the lamps at even, he shall burn incense upon it, a perpetual incense before the LORD throughout your generations."

(Exodus 30:10) "And Aaron shall make an atonement upon the horns of it once in a year with the blood of the sin offering of atonements: once in the year shall he make atonement upon it throughout your generations: it is most holy unto the LORD."

(Exodus 30:21) "So they shall wash their hands and their feet, that they die not: and it shall be a statute for ever to them, even to him and to his seed throughout their generations."

(Exodus 30:31) "And thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel, saying, This shall be an holy anointing oil unto me throughout your generations."

(Exodus 31:13) "Speak thou also unto the children of Israel, saying, Verily my sabbaths ye shall keep: for it is a sign between me and you throughout your generations; that ye may know that I am the LORD that doth sanctify you."

(Exodus 34:7) "Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation."

(Exodus 40:15) "And thou shalt anoint them, as thou didst anoint their father, that they may minister unto me in the priest's office: for their anointing shall surely be an everlasting priesthood throughout their generations."

(Leviticus 3:17) "It shall be a perpetual statute for your generations throughout all your dwellings, that ye eat neither fat nor blood."

(Leviticus 6:18) "All the males among the children of Aaron shall eat of it. It shall be a statute for ever in your generations concerning the offerings of the LORD made by fire: every one that toucheth them shall be holy."

(Leviticus 10:9) "Do not drink wine nor strong drink, thou, nor thy sons with thee, when ye go into the tabernacle of the congregation, lest ye die: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations:"

(Leviticus 7:36) "Which the LORD commanded to be given them of the children of Israel, in the day that he anointed them, by a statute for ever throughout their generations."

(Leviticus 17:7) "And they shall no more offer their sacrifices unto devils, after whom they have gone a whoring. This shall be a statute for ever unto them throughout their generations."

(Leviticus 21:17) "Speak unto Aaron, saying, Whosoever he be of thy seed in their generations that hath any blemish, let him not approach to offer the bread of his God."

(Leviticus 22:3) "Say unto them, Whosoever he be of all your seed among your generations, that goeth unto the holy things, which the children of Israel hallow unto the LORD, having his uncleanness upon him, that soul shall be cut off from my presence: I am the LORD."

(Leviticus 23:14) "And ye shall eat neither bread, nor parched corn, nor green ears, until the selfsame day that ye have brought an offering unto your God: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations in all your dwellings."

(Leviticus 23:21) "And ye shall proclaim on the selfsame day, that it may be an holy convocation unto you: ye shall do no servile work therein: it shall be a statute for ever in all your dwellings throughout your generations."

(Leviticus 23:31) "Ye shall do no manner of work: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations in all your dwellings."

(Leviticus 23:41) "And ye shall keep it a feast unto the LORD seven days in the year. It shall be a statute for ever in your generations: ye shall celebrate it in the seventh month."

(Leviticus 24:3) "Without the vail of the testimony, in the tabernacle of the congregation, shall Aaron order it from the evening unto the morning before the LORD continually: it shall be a statute for ever in your generations."

(Numbers 1:20) "And the children of Reuben, Israel's eldest son, by their generations, after their families, by the house of their fathers, according to the number of the names, by their polls, every male from twenty years old and upward, all that were able to go forth to war;"

(Numbers 1:24) "¶ Of the children of Gad, by their generations, after their families, by the house of their fathers, according to the number of the names, from twenty years old and upward, all that were able to go forth to war;"

(Numbers 1:34) "¶ Of the children of Manasseh, by their generations, after their families, by the house of their fathers, according to the number of the names, from twenty years old and upward, all that were able to go forth to war;"

(Numbers 1:36) "¶ Of the children of Benjamin, by their generations, after their families, by the house of their fathers, according to the number of the names, from twenty years old and upward, all that were able to go forth to war;"

(Numbers 1:42) "¶ Of the children of Naphtali, throughout their generations, after their families, by the house of their fathers, according to the number of the names, from twenty years old and upward, all that were able to go forth to war;"

(Numbers 3:1) "These also are the generations of Aaron and Moses in the day that the LORD spake with Moses in mount Sinai."

(Numbers 10:8) "And the sons of Aaron, the priests, shall blow with the trumpets; and they shall be to you for an ordinance for ever throughout your generations."

(Numbers 14:18) "The LORD is longsuffering, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation."

(Numbers 15:15) "One ordinance shall be both for you of the congregation, and also for the stranger that sojourneth with you, an ordinance for ever in your generations: as ye are, so shall the stranger be before the LORD."

(Numbers 15:38) "Speak unto the children of Israel, and bid them that they make them fringes in the borders of their garments throughout their generations, and that they put upon the fringe of the borders a ribband of blue:"

(Numbers 32:13) "And the LORD'S anger was kindled against Israel, and he made them wander in the wilderness forty years, until all the generation, that had done evil in the sight of the LORD, was consumed."

(Numbers 18:23) "But the Levites shall do the service of the tabernacle of the congregation, and they shall bear their iniquity: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations, that among the children of Israel they have no inheritance."

(Numbers 35:29) "So these things shall be for a statute of judgment unto you throughout your generations in all your dwellings."

(Deuteronomy 1:34-35) "And the LORD heard the voice of your words, and was wroth, and sware, saying, {35} Surely there shall not one of these men of this evil generation see that good land, which I sware to give unto your fathers,"

(Deuteronomy 2:14) "And the space in which we came from Kadesh–barnea, until we were come over the brook Zered, was thirty and eight years; until all the generation of the men of war were wasted out from among the host, as the LORD sware unto them."

(Deuteronomy 5:9-10) "Thou shalt not bow down thyself unto them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me, {10} And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me and keep my commandments."

(Deuteronomy 7:9-11) "Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations; {10} And repayeth them that hate him to their face, to destroy them: he will not be slack to him that hateth him, he will repay him to his face. {11} Thou shalt therefore keep the commandments, and the statutes, and the judgments, which I command thee this day, to do them."

(Deuteronomy 23:2-3) "A bastard shall not enter into the congregation of the LORD; even to his tenth generation shall he not enter into the congregation of the LORD. {3} An Ammonite or Moabite shall not enter into the congregation of the LORD; even to their tenth generation shall they not enter into the congregation of the LORD for ever:"

(Deuteronomy 23:8) "The children that are begotten of them shall enter into the congregation of the LORD in their third generation."

(Deuteronomy 29:21-22) "And the LORD shall separate him unto evil out of all the tribes of Israel, according to all the curses of the covenant that are written in this book of the law: {22} So that the generation to come of your children that shall rise up after you, and the stranger that shall come from a far land, shall say, when they see the plagues of that land, and the sicknesses which the LORD hath laid upon it;"

(Deuteronomy 32:5) "They have corrupted themselves, their spot is not the spot of his children: they are a perverse and crooked generation."

(Deuteronomy 32:20) "And he said, I will hide my face from them, I will see what their end shall be: for they are a very froward generation, children in whom is no faith."

Judges 2:10 And also all that generation were gathered unto their fathers: and there arose another generation after them, which knew not the Lord , nor yet the works which he had done for Israel.

Psalm 90:1,9-10 Lord, thou hast been our dwelling place in all generations. [9] For all our days are passed away in thy wrath: we spend our years as a tale that is told (Mt24:37 days of Noe) . [10] The days of our years are threescore years and ten; and if by reason of strength they be fourscore years, yet is their strength labour and sorrow; for it is soon cut off, and we fly away.

Psalm 95:10 Forty years long was I grieved with this generation, and said, It is a people that do err in their heart, and they have not known my ways:

[13] There is a generation, O how lofty are their eyes! and their eyelids are lifted up. [14] There is a

generation, whose teeth are as swords, and their jaw teeth as knives, to devour the poor from off the earth, and the needy from among men.

Ecclesiastes 1:4 One generation passeth away, and another generation cometh: but the earth abideth for ever.

(Isaiah 13:20) "It shall never be inhabited, neither shall it be dwelt in from generation to generation: neither shall the Arabian pitch tent there; neither shall the shepherds make their fold there."

(Isaiah 34:10) "It shall not be quenched night nor day; the smoke thereof shall go up for ever: from generation to generation it shall lie waste; none shall pass through it for ever and ever."

(Isaiah 34:17) "And he hath cast the lot for them, and his hand hath divided it unto them by line: they shall possess it for ever, from generation to generation shall they dwell therein."

(Isaiah 41:4) "Who hath wrought and done it, calling the generations from the beginning? I the LORD, the first, and with the last; I am he."

(Isaiah 51:8) "For the moth shall eat them up like a garment, and the worm shall eat them like wool: but my righteousness shall be for ever, and my salvation from generation to generation."

(Lamentations 5:19) "Thou, O LORD, remainest for ever; thy throne from generation to generation."

(Zechariah 7:5) "Speak unto all the people of the land, and to the priests, saying, When ye fasted and mourned in the fifth and seventh month, even those seventy years, did ye at all fast unto me, even to me?"

Matthew 1:1,17 The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham.

[17] So all the generations from Abraham to David are fourteen generations; and from David until the carrying away into Babylon are fourteen generations; and from the carrying away into Babylon unto Christ are fourteen generations.

(2018 BC - 1040 BC = 978/14=69), David to Babylon are 14G (1040-597=443/14=31), Babylon to Christ are 14G (597/14=37), Matthew 19:28 And Jesus said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That ye which have followed me, in the regeneration when the Son of man shall sit in the throne of his glory, ye also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

(Matthew 24:34) "Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled."

Matthew 11:16 But whereunto shall I liken this generation? It is like unto children sitting in the markets, and calling unto their fellows, Matthew 12:39,45 But he answered and said unto them, An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas: [45] Then goeth he, and taketh with himself seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter in and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first. Even so shall it be also unto this wicked generation.

Mark 8:12,38 And he sighed deeply in his spirit, and saith, Why doth this generation seek after a sign? verily I say unto you, There shall no sign be given unto this generation. [38] Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he cometh in the glory of his Father with the holy angels.

(Mark 13:30) "Verily I say unto you, that this generation shall not pass, till all these things be done."

Luke 1:50 And his mercy is on them that fear him from generation to generation.

(Luke 11:29-32) "¶ And when the people were gathered thick together, he began to say, This is an evil generation: they seek a sign; and there shall no sign be given it, but the sign of Jonas the prophet. {30} For as Jonas was a sign unto the Ninevites, so shall also the Son of man be to this generation. {31} The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with the men of this generation, and condemn them: for she came from the utmost parts of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon is here. {32} The men of Nineve shall rise up in the judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: for they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas is here."

(Luke 11:50-51) "That the blood of all the prophets, which was shed from the foundation of the world, may be required of this generation; {51} From the blood of Abel unto the blood of Zacharias, which perished between the altar and the temple: verily I say unto you, It shall be required of this generation."

(Luke 17:25) "But first must he suffer many things, and be rejected of this generation."

(Luke 21:32) "Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass away, till all be fulfilled."

(Hebrews 3:9-10) "When your fathers tempted me, proved me, and saw my works forty years. {10} Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said, They do alway err in their heart; and they have not known my ways."

(Hebrews 3:17) "But with whom was he grieved forty years? was it not with them that had sinned, whose carcasses fell in the wilderness?"
